Professor Dr Naseem Naqvi MBE is the founding President of The British Blockchain Association. He is the first person in the world to be awarded the UK's highest National Honour (King's Honour, MBE) for services to Blockchain and Web3 Technologies.

He is the Lead Author of the UK's National Blockchain Roadmap, published in 2021. He is an Honorary Professor of Blockchain at Epoka University, and was Named a "Think Tank" and a "Blockchain Influencer" by the UK Parliament in 2018.

Prof Naqvi is a Principal Fellow of the British Blockchain Association (BBA) and the Editor-in-Chief and Founder of the Journal of the British Blockchain Association (JBBA), World's first Open Access Scientific Blockchain journal available both in print, and online.

In 2018, Prof Naqvi was the first person in the world to coin the term "Evidence-Based Blockchain" (EBB). He is the Founding Chair of the world's first Centre for Evidence-Based Blockchain (CEBB) and the Founding Chair of the Blockchain Associations Forum (BAF), a global consortium of Blockchain associations from 51 countries across 6 continents.

He was Featured in the list of EU blockchain experts by EU Horizon 2020, Frankfurt School Blockchain Centre research. Since 2021, Prof Naqvi has also been the global head of BBA's metaverse initiatives.

He holds an MSc in Blockchain & Cryptocurrency (Awarded the prestigious 'Genesis Block Scholarship for 'Exceptional & Notable contributions to Blockchain Technology & Cryptocurrencies).

In 2019, he Chaired the World's First 'Scholars in Blockchain', International Scientific Conference in London and again in 2020, 2021, 2022, 2023 and 2024.

Since 2016, Prof Naqvi has given over 700 talks (400+ keynotes) on Web3 and Blockchain technologies and published peer-reviewed research papers in world's leading academic journals.
